WHO ARE SEBBY'S CORNER?

Sebby's Corner believes no child should go without basic essentials.

We support disadvantaged families with items such as nappies, formula, clothing and toiletries. We also have a Birthday Club and a Christmas Grotto so no child goes without a gift on these special occasions. We also offer education support including school uniform, and pregnancy support too.

We are delighted you have chosen to spend time with us. We hope to make the day as fun and rewarding as possible for you.

ON THE DAY

- Our corporate volunteering sessions usually run from 10am – 2pm, with a break for lunch. We are based at Unit G, Queens Road, Barnet, EN5 4DG.
- Tasks will vary but the main priority of our work is; checking donations, packing referrals, and organising the main hub for families and referral partners who visit on a daily basis.
- You will be guided throughout the day by one of the Sebby's Corner team members. Most of the tasks require some physical work but there are tasks for everyone. Before your corporate day, we'll ask you to read and sign a safeguarding questionnaire. You can let us know on arrival if you think there'll be any issues.
- We have found a maximum of 10 people works best for our corporate volunteering days.
- Make sure you wear comfortable clothes and shoes. Layering your clothes accordingly is a good idea as temperatures will depend on the time of year and what task you are allocated.
- We are well stocked with tea, coffee, water and snacks. You should bring your own lunch (we have a microwave) or if you prefer it is a short walk to the local high street with plenty of lunch options.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

We kindly ask for a financial contribution. This helps us to continue supporting families living in poverty. The demand for our services is huge and we need to grow to meet it. We would love to build partnerships that help both our organisations.

The cost for a corporate volunteering day for your team is based on UK staff headcount. If your organisation has under 50 employed staff members, the cost is £300. If your organisation has over 50 staff members the cost is £600.

From Barnet hospital bus stops walk up Wellhouse Lane towards Wood Street. Walk across the zebra crossing on Wood Street and turn left into Queens Road. Walk to the bottom of Queens Road to Queens Road Estate. Take an immediate left and follow the road round to Unit G
